Barbara Daus, of Platteville, has joined the staff of the Community Foundation of Southern Wisconsin. Daus will serve as the Donor Services Representative for Crawford and Grant counties in Southwest Wisconsin. She was elected to the corporate board for a third term in 2010 and was serving as the vice chair at the time of her appointment to the staff. Daus also has been a board member of the Platteville Community Fund and the PHS Scholarship Fund, components of the Community Foundation. She will relinquish all Community Foundation board positions as she assumes her new duties.
